WASA is a non-profit, **ALL-VOLUNTEER** organization formed for the purpose of conducting a youth soccer program in the Westerville area. WASA belongs to the Ohio South Youth Soccer Association, allowing it access to a wide range of resources.

Jerseys and balls are distributed in the Fall and used again for Spring. **New** players added in the Spring receive a team jersey. Replacement jerseys for returning players or a coordinator approved team change is \$15, payable at the time of registration.

Only plastic cleats may be worn, **no metal cleats**. Younger players may prefer tennis shoes. Coaches select short and sock colors. Players supply shorts, socks, shoes and shin-guards. **Shin guards are required!** For your child's safety, **no earrings** may be worn per USSF rules. To avoid tears, please plan ear piercings, and the 6 week healing process, around soccer season.

REC LEAGUES

Teams are **re-balanced** each Fall based on experience/skill level and random placement. Teams remain together Fall & Spring sessions after which they are again re-balanced going into the next Fall season. Spring vacancies are filled from new applications or, numbers and coaches permitting, new teams may be formed.

AWARDS

U5 & U6 receive participation trophies. These leagues are non-competitive, with emphasis on instruction and familiarizing the player with the sport. U7, U8 & U10 leagues participate in a "Festival Tournament", held once a year, in Fall or Spring, with participation trophies awarded. U12 leagues have traditional tournaments with first, second and participation trophies awarded. U8 Coed and Girls' U10 & U12 tournaments are in the Spring. U7, U10, U12 Coed & Girls' U8 tournaments are in the Fall.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

WASA sponsors Middle School rec teams for 7th & 8th graders. They compete with neighboring area leagues and travel locally to Columbus suburbs. They are governed by the Middle School Soccer Association (MSSA). We offer Boys & Girls teams, open to all skill levels.

HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE

WASA's hugely popular rec high school program is for kids not playing on a high school team in the fall, or a select/club team in the Spring. Coed teams, formed with an equal balance of boys & girls, play on Sunday afternoons for fun & fitness. \$55 includes jersey.

ADULT LEAGUES

Co-ed Open, 30 & 40, Women's Over 30, A & B

Adult leagues form their own teams. The emphasis is on fun & fitness. Individuals are welcomed. Team fees are apx. \$400/8wks.
